Helping Haiti Recover

Living Hope Ministries in Haiti is a Christian mission organization near Carrefour, Haiti that operates a primary school, trade school, entrepreneurship program and church. Living Hope (LHM) is about 2 miles from the epicenter of the 7.0 magnitude earthquake that hit Haiti on January 12. God has providentially protected LHM in the midst of the devastation so the mission will have a large role in the coming months in sharing God’s love in word and in action.

There are 3 primary ways you can directly help the people of Haiti – prayer, financial contributions and donation of material goods. One hundred percent of all contributions of money or goods will go to Haiti. In addition, the money contributed will help provide jobs and income to the local Haitian staff (40 people) and Haitian construction workers who will be hired for repair and construction of buildings on the LHM campus.

Financial Contributions

Financial contributions will be used for purchasing food and supplies in Haiti for both the mission and for helping the local community. They will also be used for building repairs.

Contributions of Goods

Items that will be difficult to obtain in Haiti will be shipped to LHM. There are several methods of shipping and we will be determining the best ways to get various items to Haiti over the next few months. In the meantime, please consider drives or projects to collect these items.

Food Staples & Clothing

- Peanut butter
- Non-fat dry milk (powdered)
- Canned salmon and tuna
- Pasta and pasta sides in foil bags
- Jello and pudding mixes
- Shoes & socks
- Underwear, diapers

Medical & Sanitary Supplies

- Hand sanitizer
- Gauze, tape and Band-Aids
- Alcohol wipes
- Boxes of disposable vinyl gloves
- Neosporin, Tylenol, Motrin (generics ok)
- Shampoo, soap, other toiletries

Primary School / Trade School

- Tablets, pencils, blue pens, crayons, markers
- Play dough, finger paints
- Spoons
- Chalk and erasers
- Art supplies – paints (oil, water, acrylics), canvas
- Cooking supplies – sm/med sauce pans, large cans of baking powder/soda, yeast, and cocoa, raisins, nuts

Computer Supplies (school and trade school)

- Laptops, wireless cards, external hard drives
- Ink cartridges – HP15, 17, 78. Epson 26, 600, 601, 602, 603, 604
- Xerox photocopier XC825 & XC2675 (toners and drums)
- Writable CDs, USB flash drives
- Flashlights and batteries
